



BeatEdit for Premiere Pro Installation Instructions

BeatEdit is a ZXP extension for Premiere Pro. Unfortunately, Adobe discontinued their development of Adobe Extension Manager, which was used to install ZXP extensions. Note that Adobe Extension Manager does not work anymore with CC 2014 or newer! As an alternative, we developed and maintain the *aescripts + aeplugins ZXP installer*. So please install BeatEdit using *aescripts + aeplugins ZXP installer* as described here.

Installation on Mac OS

- 1 Download and **install** **aescripts + aeplugins ZXP installer** which is available at <http://aescripts.com/learn/zxp-installer/>

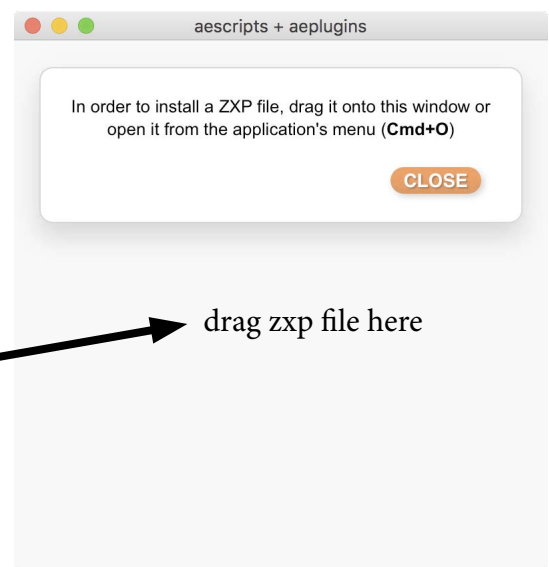
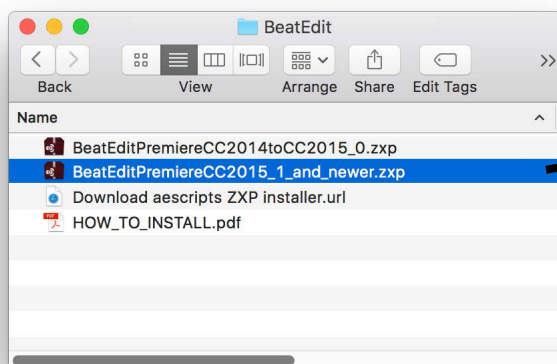

- 2 Start *aescripts + aeplugins ZXP installer* and **drag the zxp file of BeatEdit onto the installer window**

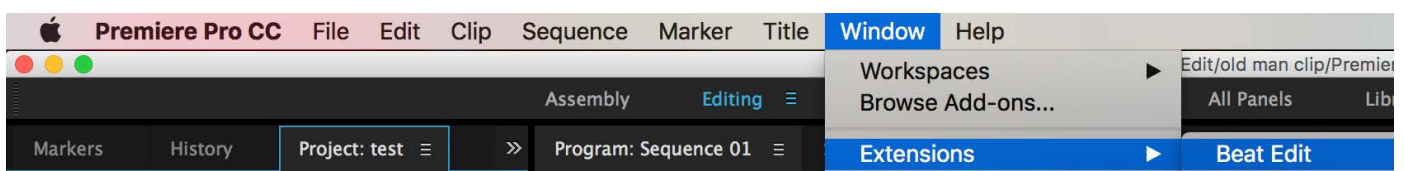
For all recent versions of Premiere Pro, use this file:
BeatEditPremiereCC2015_1_and_newer.zxp

If you are still using the old CC2014 or 2015.0, use this file instead:
BeatEditPremiereCC2014toCC2015_0.zxp

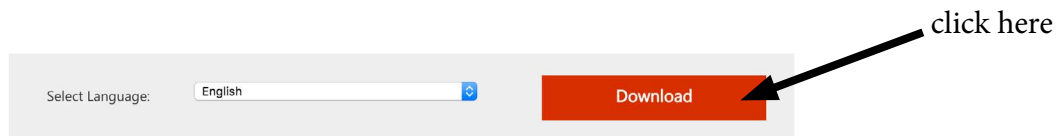
Installation on Windows

1 Download and **install** **Visual C++ Redistributable for Visual Studio 2015 x86**

which is available at

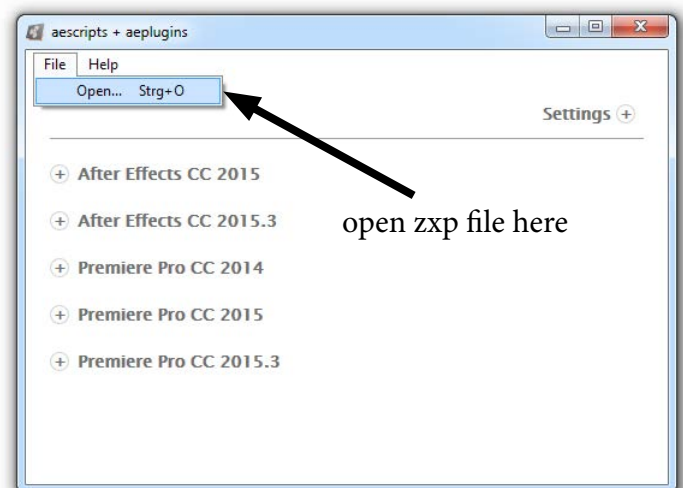


3 Start *aescripts + aeplugins ZXP installer* and **open the zxp file of BeatEdit with the installer**

BeatEditPremiereCC2014toCC2015_0.zxp
